Personal information is collected under the authority of the *Oceans Act*, the *Fisheries Act*, the *Department of Fisheries and Oceans Act*, and the *Financial Administration Act* for the purpose of administering the National Recreational Fisheries Awards Program.

Nomination information may be shared with provincial/territorial government representatives to encourage support for the nomination or to seek additional information. If the application proceeds to the final review stage, information may also be shared with the Office of the Minister of Fisheries and Oceans Canada for final approval. With the consent of the individual, award recipient information may be used and disclosed for the purpose of publishing award recipient information on the DFO website, and publishing communications material to announce award recipients.

Personal information is protected in accordance with the provisions of the *Privacy Act*. In some cases, information may be disclosed without consent for purposes authorized under subsection 8(2) of the *Privacy Act*.
